Figure 8 Race Rules

- . You must be 18 years of age to operate a vehicle in this race and have a driver's license or 16 with parental form.
- . You must be 16 years of age to enter the pit area.
- . All drivers and pit crew members must sign an insurance agreement and pay the pit gate fee upon entering.
- . The driver is the only person allowed in the car during any race.
- . There will be an entry fee of \$10.00 for each car.
- . All drivers must remain in their cars until the announcer has officially declared the heat over except in case of fire.
- . All drivers must wear helmets, full length pants, and closed toe shoes.
- . No beer in pit area.
- . Any driver that hits another car in the left front door is automatically disqualified. No exceptions!
- . Any car that cannot compete after the heat race must notify track steward.
- . Any driver not completing the course is automatically disqualified.
- . If the car is not in position when cars leave the track, it forfeits the spot and will start in the rear.
- . Any rule or regulation not covered here will be left up to the track official.

Special driving instructions will be given on the night of the race – Be there and pay attention. Entries will close after 75 cars for Heritage Days and the Fair Race. The pit gates will open at 5:30 pm for all races. No pushing vehicles. All cars should be on trailers according to Iowa law. If you register for all 5 races, you only pay for 4. - . Cars and station wagons only

- . All glass must be removed from your car, including headlights. Glass fragments must be removed from door cavities.
- . All tail lights and gas gauge wires must be cut.
- . The hood and trunk lid of your car must be chained or pinned down securely. The hood must have holes cut on both sides for extinguishing fires.
- . The doors of your car must be chained or welded securely.
- . You may not in any way block or weld your springs or do anything in any way to make your car sturdier.
- . Working seat belts are required and must be securely fastened in the car.
- . You may reinforce the driver's door only. Outside reinforcement may not extend farther than 6" in front of the door seam or 6" from rear door seam. Also, it may not stick out farther than 2" from door skin. Ends of reinforcement must be tapered and capped (Not Sharp)
- . You must have a 4-point roll cage. Specs for the roll cages are as follows:
 - . The 4 risers must be 2" pipe, other bars can be 1 1/4" pipe.
 - . There must be an x-bar behind the driver and the driver's side must be reinforced 2" bar to 2" bar.
 - . Inspectors have final say on all roll cages.
- . You must have a window cover on the driver's door – a mesh covering of some kind.
- . Fenders may be cut to size of tires only
- . You may protect radiator but it must be inside radiator grill. No back bracing farther back than 12" for the front of the radiator. No bracing allowed outside of frame rails.
- . OE manufacturer bumpers only (no homemade bumpers) in the front. No extra plating or reinforcing frame rails or bumpers in the front. No bracing outside of frame rails will be allowed.
- . All airbags must be removed.
- . Remove wheel weights from all the wheels.
- . No trailer hitches.
- . No added weight.

- . No gas tanks inside cars. It must be in normal position. If you are unable to put the gas tank in normal position put it in the trunk but it must be securely fastened and a firewall must be between tank and driver. Fuel lines must be routed and secured properly.

- . If gas tank is in the normal position it must have a metal protection bar behind it (steel bumper will work). Homemade bumpers will be allowed in the rear but cannot be wider than the car.

- . Battery can be in driver's compartment but it must be securely fastened down and covered properly.

- . All cars must have 4 numbers. The numbers on both side doors must be 18" tall and 2" wide. Also, must have standing numbers on the roof. They must be 10" tall and 6" wide. Also, must be in a contrasting color and visible from both sides. (This is what the counters use and if they cannot easily see the numbers you may not get counted.)

- . All rules subject to inspector's approval.
